Sealed bids for the Lincoln County Courthouse Column Restoration Project will be received by the Lincoln County Commission; 201 Main Street; Troy, MO; 63379; until **10:45 a.m., July 11, 2017**. This project is prevailing wage. Bids received after the above-designated time will remain unopened. All bids shall be submitted sealed in envelopes and marked "Construction for the Lincoln County Courthouse Column Renovation."

The successful bidder shall be responsible for adhering to all federal, state and local regulations referenced in the contract documents.

No bid may be withdrawn within a period of sixty (30) days from the date of the bid opening. Lincoln County reserves the right to award the contract to the lowest and best, responsive and responsible bidder(s) for the work covered by the bid and to reject any or all bids and to waive irregularities and informalities in any bid submitted. No bidder shall in any way, directly or indirectly, discriminate against any person because of age, race, color, handicaps, sex, national origin or religious creed.
